and as a professional photographer. After suffering injuries from a debilitating accident in 2009 she discovered the healing power of art through her paintbrush. "I approach my painting like I approach a relationship, unknowing where it is going, excited about the possibilities, building upon it, layer by layer, adding the colors of life and its texture until the momentary period of ugly becomes beautiful," says Amsterdam.

Amsterdam's work has been exhibited in several galleries across the country, as well as in private collections. She is a member of the Cultural Council of Palm Beach County, and Women in the Visual Arts (WITVA).

<u>Entry Rules:</u> Enter the exhibit through our website <u>www.palmbeachwatercolorsociety.com</u> Click on Shows and pay with your credit card. Do not show any frame or mat in the image and ensure the image is correctly oriented, either horizontally or vertically. <u>Eligible Artwork</u>: Watercolors, Acrylics, and water based Inks may be entered into the show. Watermedia collage made by an artist's own artwork is acceptable but newspaper, magazine or other non-water media cutouts will <u>NOT</u> be accepted. Heavy graphite, oil pastels, foils, buttons, string are also <u>NOT</u> accepted. White tissue paper, rice paper, handmade paper and washi that has been painted over by the artist is acceptable.

Oils, pastels, charcoal, drawings, photography, prints or giclees will be <u>NOT</u> be accepted. Images should be of your original art only, and not created under instruction or copied from another artist's work. Only your own, original photographs may be used for reference. Paintings that have been exhibited in prior PBWS shows are not eligible.

<u>Framing Requirements</u>: Paintings on paper must be glazed with plexiglass or varnished. Glass will not be accepted. Works on other surfaces, if not framed, must have wrapped edges, with no staples showing. All work must be wired firmly, taped and ready to hang. All entries must remain hanging for the duration of the show.

Ask the WATERCOLOR DOCTOR

Question:

Have you ever accepted a commission? Do you think it's a good idea? What are some pros and cons?


Answer:

On a few occasions I have accepted a commission for an art agent or for someone I knew. The positive aspects of this are that it is really good for one's morale, and it gets you going with a renewed energy. Of course there's always the fee that you'll be getting for your work too, which is gratifying. But after that great rush of feelings subsides, you are left to do the work of trying to paint something that you will be proud of and your client will consider beautiful.

Consider this. When a client or friend sees a group of your completed works, he or she may relate to some aspects of them in ways that you cannot fully appreciate or understand. Maybe it's the subject or even some technique of the work that they connect with. After all, each one of us has a personal aesthetic sense. Sometimes a viewer will praise some unexpected portion or color in your painting which you don't think is very special, but they love. On the other hand, sometimes paintings which are your favorites or which you think are most striking or accomplished will be totally overlooked by a viewer!

That is why, when you are doing a commissioned piece, you can only make an educated guess at what will please the client, based on your own feelings and a prior discussion of what they are looking for. But, based on my own experience with doing commissions, it can leave you unsure about adding some element or color to the work which you feel enhances it, but which might displease the person who will ultimately be buying it. Another thing to remember is that watercolor, with all of its quirks, can produce "happy accidents." You may be able to capitalize on them when you're painting the original piece, but you may not be able to recreate them again for the commission. These could be the very things the client liked or disliked about your piece. In a commissioned piece I had done many years ago for a pharmaceutical company in NJ, I had just that experience, and I somehow was able to cause the happy accident to occur once again! My personal opinion is that if people want to buy a painting of yours, it is much better to show them a body of work and let them choose what they want. You may be surprised by the outcome!
