Biography

Kathy Fieramosca is a fine arts painter working in a variety of mediums including watercolor, oil, pastel and silverpoint. Her paintings hang in various private and public collections. Public collections include Montefiore Hospital in NYC, Southern Methodist University in Dallas, TX and the CIA Museum in Langley, VA.

Ms. Fieramosca is represented by Portraits, Inc., Portrait Associates, Sewell Fine Portraiture, Francesca Anderson Fine Art and Gallery 71 in NYC. In addition to her portrait commissions, Ms. Fieramosca has been teaching watercolor painting to adults for the past 17yrs. She has taught classes through the United Federation of Teachers, Staten Island Art and Dance Center and the Art Lab of Snug Harbor, all in NYC. Having received grants through the LifeTime Arts Organization, Ms. Fieramosca has taught watercolor painting in the New York Public Library Adult Continuing Education program throughout NYC. Since 2021she has also taught plein air landscape painting workshops in Italy, Sicily, England and other parts of Europe.

Kathy Fieramosca has a BFA from the Columbus College of Art and Design in Columbus, Ohio. In addition, she has studied at the Art Students League, The National Academy of Design, Grand Central Art Academy, and privately with Michael Aviano, Jon DeMartin, and Daniel Greene.

Ask the

WATERCOLOR DOCTOR

Question:

I paint at home and don't have someone to go to for advice about my work. Are there some rules about making good paintings, or are there some common mistakes which I can be aware of?

Answer:


Last month I wrote about one of the most essential aspects of a good painting...color usage. This month I'll be telling you about another very important aspect of good painting...composition.

What are some elements of good composition? If you look it up online, you'll see there are many offered, but here are some that I consider to be the top contenders...HARMONY, UNITY, MOVEMENT, RHYTHM, BALANCE, and most of all EMPHASIS. But emphasis really means establishing a focal point. If you aren't familiar with the RULE OF THIRDS, which greatly helps in understanding where to place your focal point, I'll explain it. If you were to divide your paper into thirds, both vertically and horizontally, the four intersections of those lines would be the ideal places to locate your focal point. I generally favor the upper two, because I feel that gives my paintings a feeling of lightness, and I often paint weightier shapes toward the bottom of my paintings, but that's my personal take on the subject.

Well then, how do you go about accomplishing this? The contributing elements would be MOVEMENT, and RHYTHM, to direct the viewer's eye around the painting and ultimately to the focal point. This can be accomplishes through LINE, or PATTERN, or TEXTURE, but we must remember to consider UNITY and HARMONY in using these design elements. These can be carried out if we remember REPETITION of elements in our paintings. They can be colors, textures, patterns, shapes or even representational objects. They need to appear in several places in the piece, like supporting actors in a play or stepping stones across a stream.

As you work, think of these factors. Put your painting down on the floor to evaluate it, or even take a photo of it on your phone and examine it. You'll quickly see what aspects are working and which need to be changed. Good luck and happy painting!
